It's great to be back at Cold Spring E.S. This class is for all levels of students in grades K-5 from New Players (just learning the Pieces) to Advanced Students who have previous experience and may have even played in organized competitions. Class time will be divided between a lesson and a game play portion. Instruction for new students will include the basics of how the pieces move, board set up, simple opening strategy and checkmate skills. Advanced students will cover tactics and strategy, more detailed openings and game analysis. We will provide information and a location for practice outside of class including access to weekly tournaments. We focus on sportsmanship and healthy competition and a sense of teamwork while we work towards self-improvement.
